2 Cor. 10:3-5 – Taking every thought captive.

Isaiah 26:3-4 – will keep in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You.

Ps. 16:7-11- I will bless the Lord who has counseled me

TRIBULATION

2 Cor. 4:17-18 – light momentary afflictions

Heb 12:2-4- looking to Jesus- author and finisher- not yet shed blood

Rom. 5:2-3- rejoice in suffering- produces perseverance, etc.

Rom. 8:18- sufferings not worthy to be compared to the glory...

Jam. 1:2- consider it pure joy

Phil. 3:7-10- all things loss compared to knowing Him

Psalm 32:6-11- surrounds us with songs of deliverance

Psalm 119:67 & 71- God uses the affliction to sanctify us.

Psalm 25- My eyes are always looking to the Lord, for He alone can rescue me.

I Cor. 10:13- God is faithful... won't let us be tempted (tried) beyond what we can bear. Other people have faced similar things- even Jesus has.

2 Cor. 1:3-11

SATISFACTION IN HIM

Hab. 3:17-19- though bad things are happening- will rejoice in Him.

Psalm 42- should long for Him as a parched animal longs for water- instead we seek cheap substitutes.

Psalm 17:8 & 15- He treasures me, I will be satisfied in Him.

Jer. Chapters 2 & 3 -picture the vanity of turning from God and seeking other things to find satisfaction- leads us into misery. God compares this idolatry to unfaithfulness in marriage, yet He longs to heal and restore.

Jer. 9:23-24- boast only in knowing Him.

Ps. 16:11- in His presence, there is fullness of joy.

Ps. 34:8-9- taste and see that the Lord is good.

Hebrews 13:5 He will never leave or forsake... be content.

SELF PITY

Jonah 4

1 Cor. 15:19- we have eternal hope beyond temporary circumstances

Mt. 16:24- must deny self

TEMPTATION

I Cor. 10:13

Hebrews 4:14-16 –tempted in every way and without sin...Since he was able to say no to temptation, he is our priest and enables us to approach the throne of grace with confidence. Grace to make it in times of trouble.

2 Cor. 12:7-10

TRUTH

Jer. 17:9- truth is not in us.

John 8:32 -sets us free!

Psalm 51:6

Psalm 119:160 & John 17:17- His word is truth.

John 14:6-Jesus (the Word made flesh) is the truth.

Phil. 4:8- think on things that are true. Must replace lies we believe with His truth.
